What You'll See...

A-Wolfeboro's Waterfront

On beautiful Lake Winnepesaukee you can take an antique boat ride or ride the mailboat on the "Big Lake," watch private boaters come and go at the town docks, enjoy free concerts at the community bandstand, and dine at a choice of restaurants with outdoor seating.

B-Brewster Academy

Established in 1887, Brewster is now a private coeducational high school serving up to 350 students from all over the world. In summer it is home to Heifetz International Music Institute and Great Waters Music Festival.

C-The Clark House, Pleasant Valley Schoolhouse and Monitor Hose Co.

All are located on the Wolfeboro Historical Society's Clark House Museum grounds. Built in 1778, the Clark House is in excellent condition and houses many antiques from that period. Restored early fire equipment is exhibited in the Monitor building, a replica of the original once in South Wolfeboro.

D-The Wright Museum

This museum in Wolfeboro Falls tells the story of America during the years 1939-1945 with exhibits of World War II equipment, uniforms and memorabilia from the "Homefront."

E-Klickety Klack Railroad

The hobby shop features a working model railroad city with 26 running trains, 150 locomotives and 70 buttons you (and your kids) can operate.

F-New Hampshire Boat Museum

This museum has permanent and rotating exhibits of antique and classic boats of all sizes and power as well as lake memorabilia dating to the 1800s.

G-Wolfeboro Railroad Station

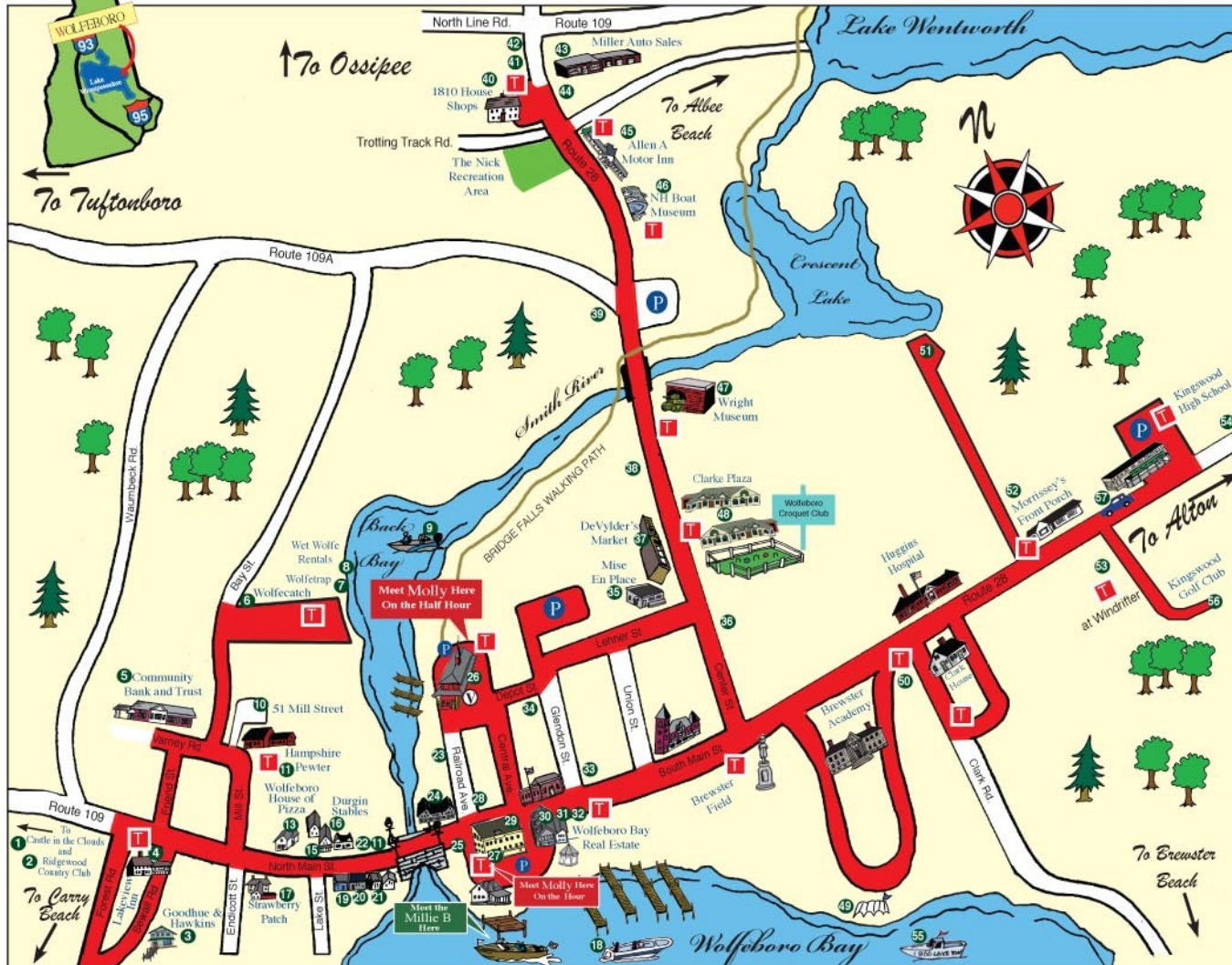
Built in 1872, the restored depot is now home to the Wolfeboro Chamber of Commerce and the Visitors' Center, where you'll find friendly folks to welcome you.

H-Hampshire Pewter

On Wolfeboro's Back Bay, this local business offers free tours where you can see original Queen's Metal pewter hand-cast and finished while you watch.

I-Sewall Road

Following the shore along Lake Winnepesaukee, you'll see some of Wolfeboro's most beautiful lakeside homes.
